INFORSE – EREF Seminar



- 20 % Energy Efficiency mentioned in Grenelle law (2009)
- EE in new buildings
 - 50 kWh/m² regulation for new buildings from 2013
 - The end of specific regulation for electric heating
 - Positive energy from 2020

Existing buildings: -38 %
consumption by 2020

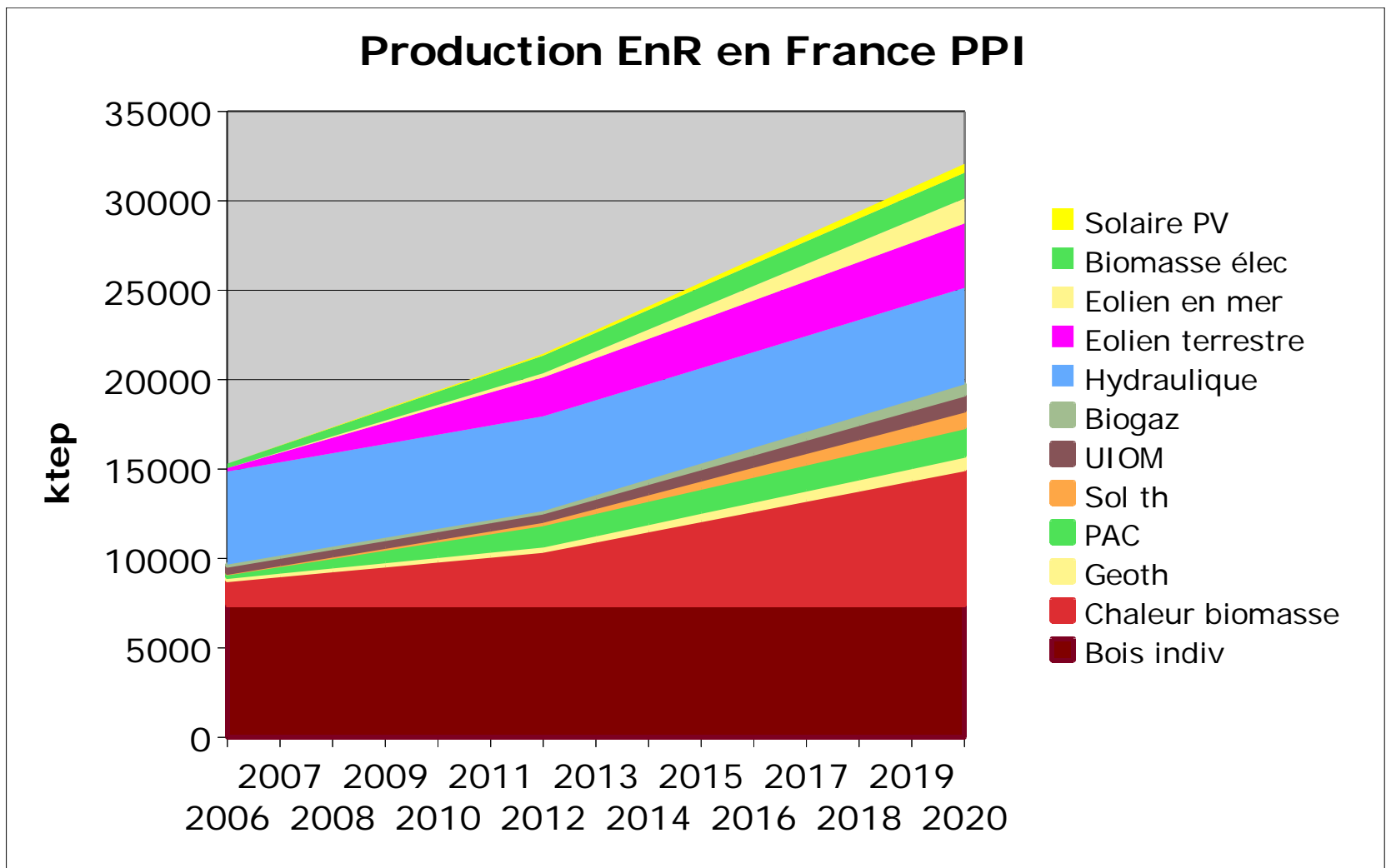


- 23 % Renewable passed (2009)
 - RES-E
 - FIT quite well designed
 - 29 %
 - RES-H
 - Heat fund (eq to FIT)
- Biogas
Grid-Injection (FIT to be created)



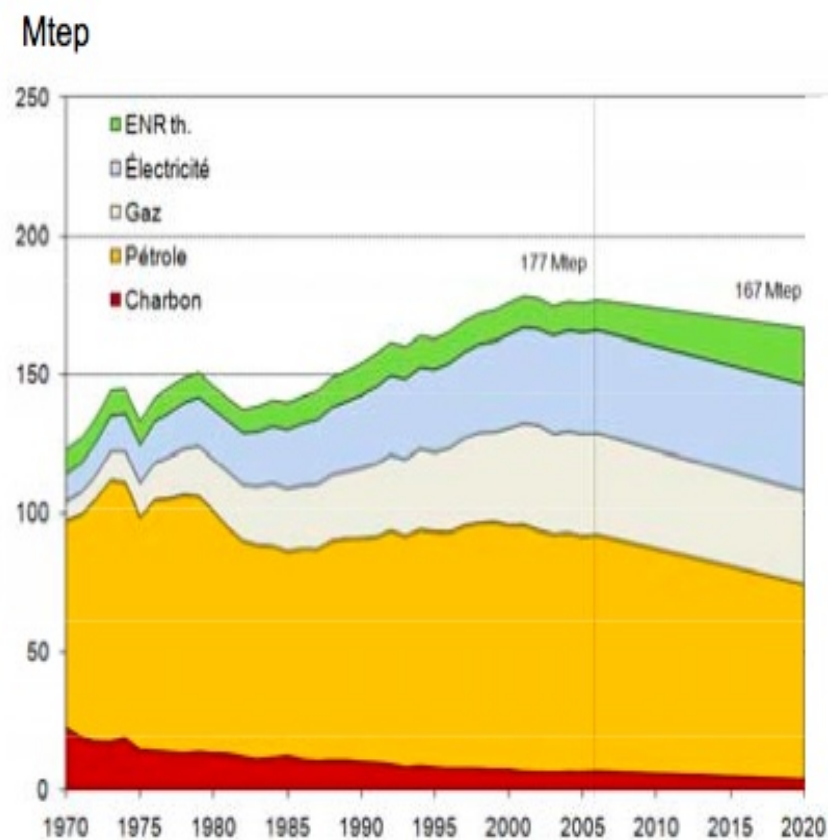
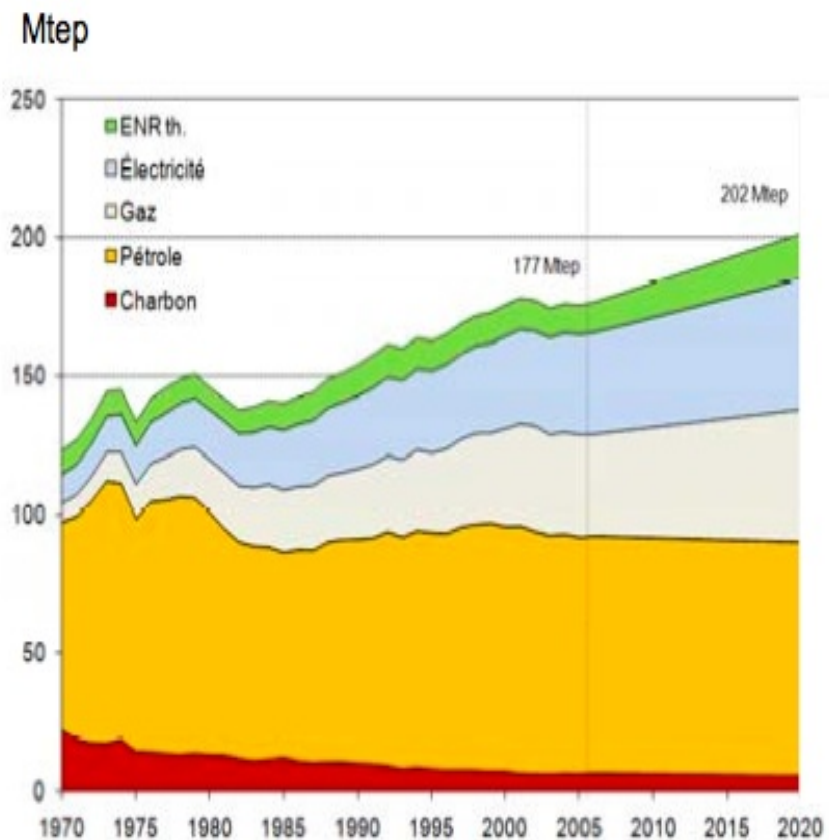
- Carbon tax
- Local energy action plan for municipalities > 50 000 inhab
- NGOs and charities always part of discussion process





- Training aspects of the directive
- Clear electricity plan (more RES + more nuke + more gas = too much)
- Clear position on RES transfer (apparently no transfer planned but Plan Solaire Méditerranée mentioned)
- Clear biofuels policy
- Guidelines for a fair and strong 20% EE
- Decentralisation of decision making on energy

- N Sarkozy party lost regional elections / Greens were very strong

 - Only > 15 MW wind farms
 - Classified under polluting sites regulation

- Harder for NGOs / Charities to be heard
