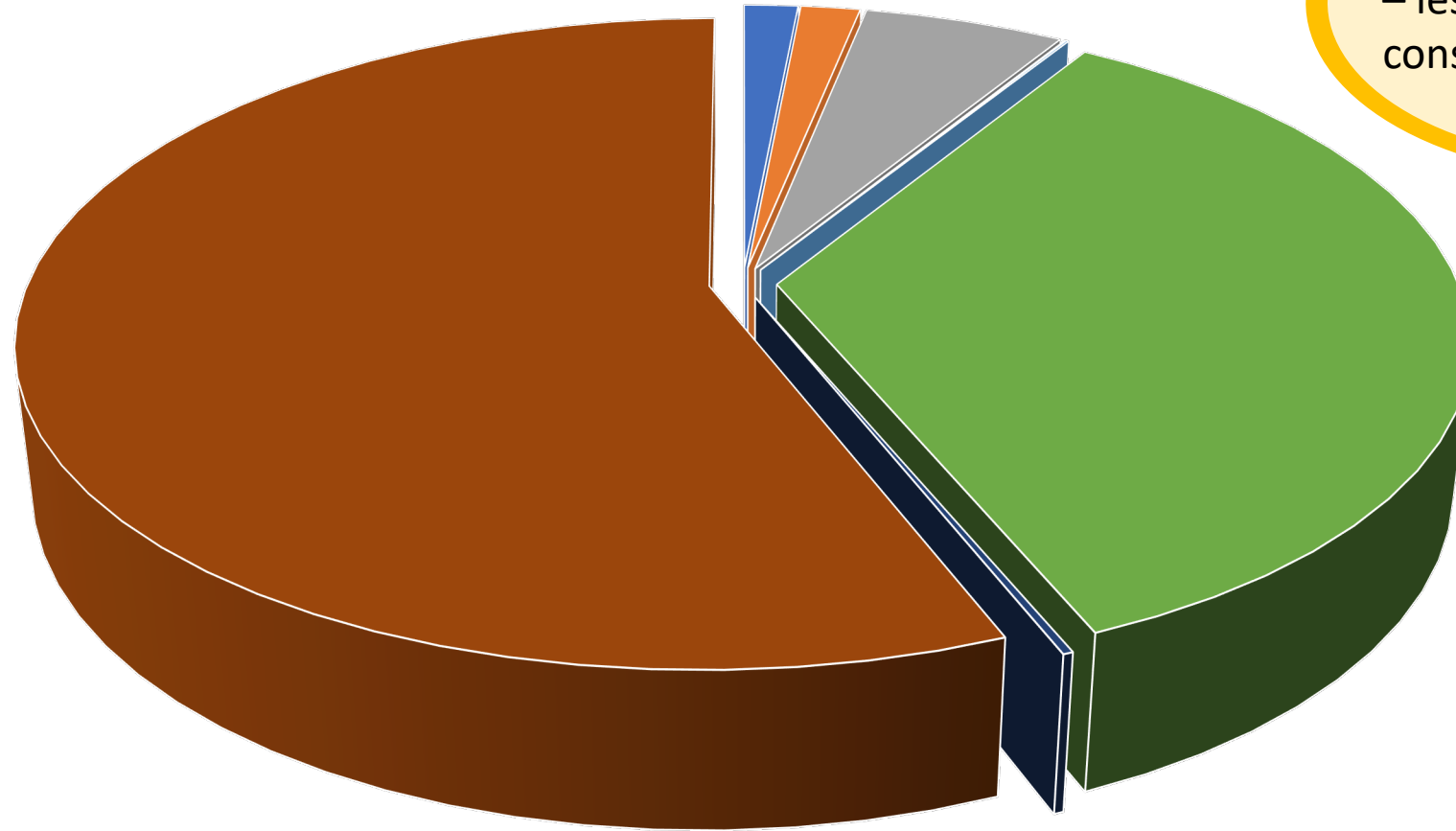

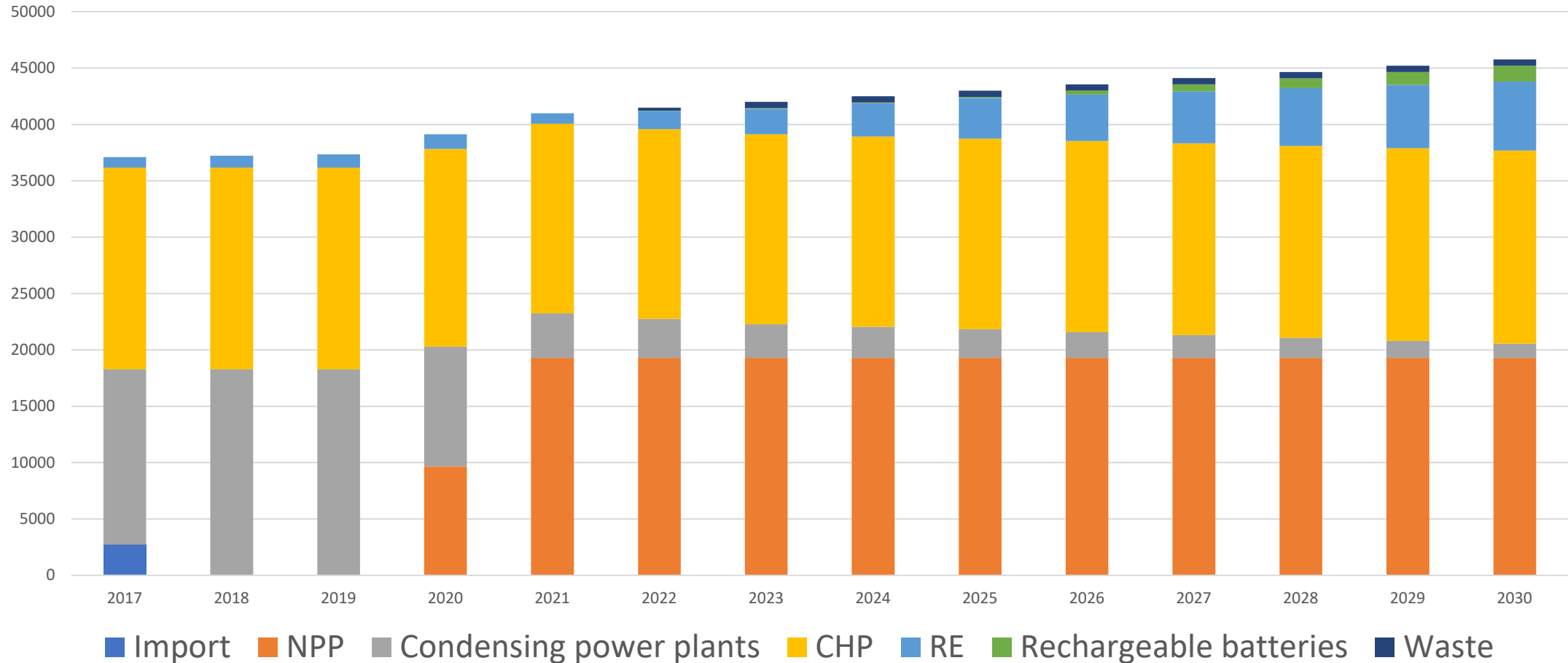
What energy resources does Belarus consume?

In total, **56** cities and districts of Belarus are signatories to the Covenant of mayors.

The total population in these cities is **4.1** million people.

This means that almost **every second** Belarusians live in a city that has signed Covenant of mayors
