

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· Is education leading us to sustainability?

Realities

- · Reproducing an unsustainable world
- Need to change education system and practice

- Over 70% of UK households never examined ways to save energy (EST)
- The amount of energy we use for transport and in our homes has increased dramatically since 1980, from 18% to 35% and 40% to 49% respectively (Environment Agency)
- 13% of Brits surveyed left the television on standby for the duration of their holiday, costing a collective £250,000 in wasted energy. (EST)

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For every £1 saved on fuel bills, energy consumption is reduced by about 34kWh and CO_2 emissions by around 8.5 kgs of CO_2 .


Energy use has an impact on all the key concepts
